27 in the Bernard Blackwell Mississippi High School All-Star Classic 28 and being honored as District Coach of the Year eight times; and 29 WHEREAS, Coach Peters has achieved many firsts in his career, 30 he was the first African-American coach to win the Class 3A State 31 Championship, the first African-American coach to be named The 32 Clarion-Ledger All-State Coach of the Year and the first 33 African-American coach to be designated as the Head Coach in the 34 Mississippi/Alabama All-Star Classic; and
