32 All-State Team, *Clarion-Ledger* Dandy Dozen, Gatorade Mississippi
33 Player of the Year nominee, Parade All-American nominee, ranked
34 No. 2 guard in the nation by Scout.com; State Championship Game
35 most valuable player, the leading scorer and rebounder, averaging
