WHEREAS, subsequent to his matriculation in higher education, 10 11 Mr. Walker served in the United States Army during World War II before embarking on a career in industrial manufacturing; and 12 13 WHEREAS, Mr. Walker and his wife, Gladys, moved to and 14 founded Delta Wire Corporation in Clarksdale, Mississippi, in 15 1978, building the company into an award winning, nationally 16 recognized supplier of a superior drawn wire product, and becoming 17 a major supplier to international manufacturers requiring superior bead wire for their products, ranging from reinforcement for 18 tires, to contact springs in flashlights, to trans-oceanic wire 19 for the communications industry; and 20 21 WHEREAS, Mr. Walker's interest in his community moved him to
