HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 136

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING REVEREND JACK EZELL ON HIS FORTIETH
2 ANNIVERSARY AS THE PASTOR OF THE TUPELO CHURCH OF GOD.

3 WHEREAS, Reverend Jack Ezell was born June 1, 1936, to Mr.
4 and Mrs. W.J. Ezell in Carroll County, Mississippi; and

5 WHEREAS, Reverend Ezell was ordained in the ministry in July
6 1961; and

7 WHEREAS, Reverend Ezell was ordained in the Church of God in
8 Cleveland, Tennessee, by Dr. Ray H. Hughes, the General Overseer,
9 on April 17, 1972; and

10 WHEREAS, Reverend Ezell moved to Tupelo, Mississippi, on July
11 4, 1965, and organized the Tupelo Church of God in June 1967 with
12 six members; and

13 WHEREAS, under Reverend Ezell's spiritual leadership, the
14 Tupelo Church of God now has over 600 members; and

15 WHEREAS, a loving husband and father, Reverend Ezell is
16 married to Bobbie Dean Lee Ezell, and they are the proud parents
17 of three children, Grant Jerome, Terry Eugene and Jacqueline
18 LaDean and several grandchildren; and

19 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
20 commend the great citizens of the State of Mississippi:
