## SENATE BILL NO. 2012

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-7-67, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2	ALLOW EMERGENCY AND LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLES TO USE TIRES WITH
3	STUDS DURING SNOW OR ICY CONDITIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-7-67, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 63-7-67. Every solid rubber tire on a vehicle shall have
- 8 rubber on its entire traction surface at least one (1) inch thick
- 9 above the edge of the flange of the entire periphery.
- 10 No person shall operate or move on any highway any motor
- 11 vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer having any metal tire in contact
- 12 with the roadway.
- No tire on a vehicle moved on a highway shall have on its
- 14 periphery any block, stud, flange, cleat, or spike or any other
- 15 protuberances of any material other than rubber which projects
- 16 beyond the tread of the traction surface of the tire. However, it
- 17 shall be permissible to use farm machinery with tires having
- 18 protuberances which will not injure the highway, and it shall be
- 19 permissible to use tire chains of reasonable proportions upon any
- 20 vehicle when required for safety because of snow, ice, or other
- 21 conditions tending to cause a vehicle to skid.
- It is permissible to use tires with studs on emergency and
- 23 law enforcement vehicles when required for public safety because
- 24 of snow, ice or other conditions causing a vehicle to skid.
- The Mississippi Department of Transportation and local
- 26 authorities in their respective jurisdictions may, in their
- 27 discretion, issue special permits authorizing the operation upon a

- 28 highway of traction engines or tractors having movable tracks with
- 29 transverse corrugations upon the periphery of such movable tracks
- 30 or farm tractors or other farm machinery, the operation of which
- 31 upon a highway would otherwise be prohibited under this title.
- 32 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 33 and after July 1, 2007.
