- 9 however, \* \* \* the board of supervisors may, in its discretion,
- 10 pay the managers and clerks an additional amount not to exceed
- 11 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per election. The manager or other
- 12 person who shall carry to the place of voting, away from the
- 13 courthouse, the official ballots, ballot boxes, pollbooks and
- 14 other necessities, shall be allowed Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each
- 15 voting precinct for so doing. The manager or other person who
- 16 acts as returning officer shall be allowed Ten Dollars (\$10.00)
