AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-1-43, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 PROVIDE THAT A PERSON MAY DONATE TO THE STATEWIDE LITTER 2 3 PREVENTION FUND TO BE EXPENDED AS APPROVED BY KEEP MISSISSIPPI BEAUTIFUL, INC., WHEN THE PERSON RECEIVES HIS REGULAR DRIVER'S LICENSE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 5 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 63-1-43, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 8 amended as follows: 63-1-43. (1) The fee for receiving the application and 9 issuing the regular driver's or operator's license and the fee for 10 renewing the license shall be: 11 (a) Eighteen Dollars (\$18.00) plus the applicable 12 photograph fee for each applicant for a four-year license; 13 (b) Three Dollars (\$3.00) plus the applicable 14 15 photograph fee for each applicant for a one-year license, except as provided in paragraph (c) of this subsection; * * * 16 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) plus the applicable 17 (C) photograph fee for a one-year license for each applicant who is 18 19 not a United States citizen and who does not possess a social security number issued by the United States government; and 20 21 (d) In addition to the fees required in paragraph (a) of this section, an applicant may contribute an additional One 2.2 Dollar (\$1.00) which shall be deposited into the Statewide Litter 23 Prevention Fund. The applicant shall be informed that he may 24 contribute an additional One Dollar (\$1.00) which shall be 25 deposited into the Statewide Litter Prevention Fund and shall be 26 expended solely for the purpose of funding litter prevention 27 28 projects or litter education programs, as recommended by the

All originals and renewals of regular operators' licensesshall be in compliance with Section 63-1-47.

33 (2) The fee for receiving the application and issuing a 34 motorcycle endorsement shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00). Motorcycle 35 endorsements shall be valid for the same period of time as the 36 applicant's operator's license.

37 (3) The fee for receiving the application and issuing a 38 restricted motorcycle operator's license and the fee for renewing 39 such license shall be:

40 (a) Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) plus the applicable41 photograph fee for a four-year license; and

42 (b) Eight Dollars (\$8.00) plus the applicable43 photograph fee for a one-year license.

All originals and renewals of restricted motorcycle licenses shall be valid for the same period of time that an original regular driver's license may be issued to such person in compliance with Section 63-1-47.

48 (4) From and after January 1, 1990, every person who makes 49 application for an original license or a renewal license to 50 operate a vehicle as a common carrier by motor vehicle, taxicab, 51 passenger coach, dray, contract carrier or private commercial 52 carrier as such terms are defined in Section 27-19-3, except for 53 those vehicles for which a Class A, B or C license is required 54 under Article 2 of this chapter, shall, in lieu of the regular 55 driver's license above provided for, apply for and obtain a Class 56 D commercial driver's license. Except as otherwise provided in subsection (5) of this section, the fee for the issuance of a 57 58 Class D commercial driver's license shall be Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) plus the applicable photograph fee for a period of four 59 60 (4) years; however, except as required under Article 2 of this chapter, no driver of a pickup truck shall be required to have a 61 * SS02/ R454* S. 62 commercial license regardless of the purpose for which the pickup 63 truck is used.

Except as otherwise provided in subsection (5) of this 64 section, all originals and renewals of commercial licenses issued 65 66 under this section shall be valid for a period of four (4) years, 67 in compliance with Section 63-1-47. Only persons who operate the 68 above-mentioned vehicles in the course of the regular and 69 customary business of the owner shall be required to obtain a Class D commercial operator's license, and persons operating such 70 71 vehicles for private purposes or in emergencies shall not be required to obtain such license. 72

The original and each renewal of a commercial driver's 73 (5) 74 license issued under this section to a person who is not a United 75 States citizen and who does not possess a social security number issued by the United States government shall be issued for a 76 77 period of one (1) year for a fee of Eight Dollars (\$8.00) plus the 78 applicable photograph fee and shall expire one (1) year from the 79 date of issuance. Such person may renew a commercial license issued under this section within thirty (30) days of expiration of 80 81 the license.

(6) The Commissioner of Public Safety, by rule or 82 83 regulation, shall establish a driver's license photograph fee 84 which shall be the actual cost of the photograph rounded off to the next highest dollar. Monies collected for the photograph fee 85 86 shall be deposited into a special photograph fee account which the Department of Public Safety shall use to pay the actual cost of 87 88 producing the photographs. Any monies collected in excess of the actual costs of the photography shall be deposited to the General 89 Fund of the State of Mississippi. 90

91 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 92 and after July 1, 2007.
