SENATE BILL NO. 2241

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-1-35, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PROVIDE FOR A SPECIAL FORM OF DRIVER'S LICENSE TO BE ISSUED TO 3 HONORABLY RETIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 63-1-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

63-1-35. (1) The Commissioner of Public Safety shall 8 9 prescribe the form of licenses issued pursuant to this article which shall, among other features, include a driver's license 10 11 number assigned by the Department of Public Safety which, at the option of the licensee, may or may not be the social security 12 number of the licensee. A licensee who chooses not to use his 13 social security number as his driver's license number, except as 14 15 otherwise provided under subsection (2) of this section, shall 16 list his social security number with the department which shall 17 cross reference the social security number with the driver's license number for purposes of identification. Additionally, each 18 license shall bear a full face color photograph of the licensee in 19 such form that the license and the photograph cannot be separated. 20 21 Such photograph shall be taken so that one (1) exposure will photograph the applicant and the application simultaneously on the 22 same film. The department shall use a process in the issuance of 23 24 a license with a color photograph which shall prevent as nearly as possible any alteration, counterfeiting, duplication, 25 26 reproduction, forging or modification of such license or the superimposition of a photograph without ready detection. 27 Such 28 photograph shall be replaced by the department at the time of * SS02/ R596* S. 29 renewal. Driver licenses, including photographs appearing 30 thereon, may be renewed by electronic means according to rules and 31 regulations promulgated by the commissioner. The Department of 32 Public Safety may accept bank credit cards and debit cards in 33 payment of fees for driver license renewals that are processed by 34 electronic means and, if authorized by general law, may charge an 35 additional fee for the use of such cards.

(2) The commissioner shall prescribe the form of licenses 36 issued pursuant to this article to licensees who are not United 37 38 States citizens and who do not possess a social security number issued by the United States government. The licenses of such 39 persons shall include a number and/or other identifying features. 40 (3) The commissioner shall prescribe a form of license 41 42 issued pursuant to this article to licensees who are honorably retired law enforcement officers designating the retirement status 43 44 of the licensee; proof of the licensee's status as an honorably 45 retired law enforcement officer may be submitted pursuant to the 46 form promulgated by the commissioner under Section 45-9-101. 47 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 48 and after July 1, 2007.
