SENATE BILL NO. 2302

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-3-603, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO REQUIRE MOTORISTS TRAVELING ON A HIGHWAY THAT HAS BEEN DIVIDED 2 3 INTO FOUR OR MORE LANES TO TRAVEL IN THE RIGHT LANE AND YIELD TO 4 MOTORISTS TRAVELING AT A GREATER RATE OF SPEED; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 63-3-603, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 8 amended as follows: 9 63-3-603. (1) Whenever any roadway has been divided into three (3) or more clearly marked lanes for traffic, except through 10 or bypassing a municipality, the following rules in addition to 11 12 all others consistent herewith shall apply: (a) A vehicle shall be driven as nearly as practical 13 14 entirely within a single lane and shall not be moved from such lane until the driver has first ascertained that such movement can 15 be made with safety. 16 (b) A vehicle shall not be driven in the center lane 17 upon a roadway which is divided into three (3) lanes except when: 18 19 (i) Overtaking and passing another vehicle where the roadway is clearly visible and such center lane is clear of 20 21 traffic within a safe distance; 2.2 (ii) Such vehicle is in preparation for a left 23 turn; or (iii) Such center lane is at the time allocated 24 exclusively to traffic moving in the direction such vehicle is 25 proceeding and is signposted to give notice of such allocation. 26 27 (c) Official signs may be erected directing slow-moving 28 traffic to use a designated lane or allocating specified lanes to

29 traffic moving in the same direction, and drivers of vehicles 30 shall obey the directions of every such sign.

31 (d) Upon all roadways any vehicle proceeding at less 32 than the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under 33 the conditions then existing shall be driven in the right-hand 34 lane then available for traffic, or as close as practicable to the 35 right-hand curb or edge of the roadway, except when overtaking and 36 passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction or when preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into a private 37 38 road or driveway.

(e) Persons riding bicycles upon a roadway shall not ride more than two (2) abreast except on paths or parts of roadways set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles. Persons riding two (2) abreast shall not impede the normal and reasonable movement of traffic and, on a laned roadway, shall ride within a single lane.

45 (2) Motorists traveling on any highway that has been divided 46 into four (4) or more clearly marked lanes for traffic shall 47 travel in the right lane and shall yield to motorists traveling at 48 a greater rate of speed. Violators shall be fined Twenty-five 49 Dollars (\$25.00).

50 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 51 and after July 1, 2007.
