SENATE BILL NO. 2317

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-1-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
 RESTRICT THE DRIVING ACTIVITIES AS TO ALLOWABLE PASSENGERS
 PERMITTED TO THE HOLDER OF AN INTERMEDIATE DRIVER'S LICENSE; AND
 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. Section 63-1-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7 amended as follows:

8 63-1-21. (1) Every applicant for a new or original driver's 9 or operator's license, except persons holding an out-of-state 10 license, shall first obtain a temporary driving permit upon the 11 payment of a fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) to the Department of Public 12 Safety and upon the successful completion of the examination 13 provided for in Section 63-1-33 and the payment of the fee for 14 such examination provided for in Section 63-1-43.

15 (2) A temporary driving permit entitles the holder, provided 16 the permit is in his immediate possession, to drive a motor 17 vehicle other than a motorcycle on the highways of the State of Mississippi only when accompanied by a licensed operator who is at 18 least twenty-one (21) years of age and who is actually occupying 19 the seat beside the driver. A temporary driving permit may be 20 21 issued to any applicant who is at least fifteen (15) years of age. 22 A temporary driving permit shall be valid for a period of one (1) year from the date of issue. 23

(3) (a) An intermediate license allows unsupervised driving
from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. At all other times the intermediate
licensee must be supervised by a parent, guardian or other person
age twenty-one (21) years or older who holds a valid driver's

28 license under this article and who is actually occupying the seat
29 beside the driver.

(b) A person driving under an intermediate driver's 30 license shall not operate a motor vehicle with more than one (1) 31 32 passenger in the motor vehicle unless: The intermediate licensee is supervised by a 33 (i) 34 parent, guardian or other person who is twenty-one (21) years of age or older who holds a valid driver's license under this 35 36 article, and who is actually occupying the vehicle; or 37 (ii) Any minor passengers in excess of the one 38 permitted under this paragraph are siblings or stepsiblings of the driver or are adopted or foster children residing in the same 39 40 household as the driver, and the driver is in possession of a 41 letter from the driver's parent or legal guardian authorizing the passengers to be in the motor vehicle for the sole purpose of 42 43 going to or from school. 44 (4) The fee for issuance of an intermediate license shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00). 45 46 (5) Except as otherwise provided by Section 63-1-6, every 47 applicant for a restricted motorcycle operator's license or a motorcycle endorsement shall first obtain a temporary motorcycle 48 49 driving permit upon the payment of a fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) to 50 the Department of Public Safety, and upon the successful

51 completion of the examination provided for in Section 63-1-33, and 52 payment of the fee for said examination provided for in Section 63-1-43. All applicants for such temporary permit shall (a) be at 53 54 least fifteen (15) years of age; (b) operate a motorcycle only 55 under the direct supervision of a person at least twenty-one (21) years of age who possesses either a valid driver's or operator's 56 57 license with a motorcycle endorsement or a valid restricted motorcycle operator's license; (c) be prohibited from transporting 58 59 a passenger on a motorcycle; (d) be prohibited from operating a 60 motorcycle upon any controlled access highway; and (e) be

No. 2317 * SS02/ R431* 07/SS02/R431 PAGE 2 61 prohibited from operating a motorcycle during the hours of 6:00 62 p.m. through 6:00 a.m. Temporary motorcycle driving permits shall 63 be valid for the same period of time and may be renewed upon the 64 same conditions as temporary driving permits issued for vehicles 65 other than motorcycles.

66 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 67 and after July 1, 2007.
