SENATE BILL NO. 2366

AN ACT TO CREATE THE HURRICANE KATRINA MEMORIAL COMMISSION TO 1 2 DETERMINE THE TYPE AND SITE OF AN APPROPRIATE STATE MEMORIAL FOR 3 THOSE WHO LOST THEIR LIVES IN MISSISSIPPI AS A RESULT OF HURRICANE 4 KATRINA; TO PROVIDE FOR ITS MEMBERSHIP AND DUTIES; TO PROVIDE FOR A COMMISSION REPORT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. (1) (a) The Legislature of Mississippi hereby 7 8 recognizes that the events of August 29, 2005, and the days 9 following, when Hurricane Katrina struck Mississippi a deadly blow and so many in Mississippi lost their lives, are among the most 10 historic in the entire history of Mississippi. 11 12 (b) The Legislature further recognizes that it is 13 appropriate for the state to commemorate this tragic event and to memorialize the hundreds of citizens who lost their lives. 14 15 (C) The Legislature declares, therefore, that it is the purpose of this act to create the Hurricane Katrina Memorial 16 Commission to make recommendations for an appropriate memorial to 17 commemorate those who lost their lives in Mississippi in Hurricane 18 19 Katrina. The Hurricane Katrina Memorial Commission, hereafter 20 (2)referred to as the "commission," is hereby created and established 21 in the Office of the Governor. 2.2 (3) The commission shall consist of sixteen (16) members 23 appointed as follows to serve at the will and pleasure of the 24 appointing authority: 25

26 (a) Four (4) members appointed by the Governor.
27 (b) Three (3) members appointed by the Lieutenant
28 Governor.

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29 (C) Three (3) members appointed by the Speaker of the 30 House of Representatives. 31 (d) One (1) member appointed by the Hancock County 32 Board of Supervisors. 33 (e) One (1) member appointed by the Harrison County 34 Board of Supervisors. 35 (f) One (1) member appointed by the Jackson County Board of Supervisors. 36 One (1) member appointed by the City of Biloxi 37 (g) 38 Board of Aldermen/City Council. 39 One (1) member appointed by the City of Gulfport (h) Board of Aldermen/City Council. 40 (i) One (1) member appointed by the City of Pascagoula 41 Board of Aldermen/City Council. 42 (j) One (1) member appointed by the City of Ocean 43 44 Springs Board of Aldermen/City Council. 45 (k) One (1) member appointed by the City of Long Beach Board of Aldermen/City Council. 46 47 One (1) member appointed by the City of Pass (1) 48 Christian Board of Aldermen/City Council. 49 One (1) member appointed by the City of Bay St. (m) 50 Louis Board of Aldermen/City Council. 51 (n) One (1) member appointed by the City of Waveland 52 Board of Aldermen/City Council. 53 (o) One (1) member appointed by the City of Gautier 54 Board of Aldermen/City Council. The members of the commission shall elect a chairman, 55 (4) vice chairman and other officers as they deem necessary for the 56 efficient operation of the business of the commission. 57 58 (5) The members of the commission shall serve without compensation, but they shall be reimbursed on a vouchered basis 59 60 for actual expenses, including travel expenses, to the extent that funds are made available for such purpose. 61 * SS26/ R26* S. 07/SS26/R26 PAGE 2 62 (6) A vacancy in the membership of the commission shall be63 filled in the same manner as the original appointment.

64 (7) The commission shall meet at such times and places as it 65 may designate. All meetings shall be held at the call of the 66 chairman or at the call of a quorum of members upon not less than 67 seven (7) days written notice, unless notice is waived. Α 68 majority of the members of the commission shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any and all business at any regular 69 or special meeting. The first meeting of the commission shall be 70 71 held within ninety (90) days after the effective date of this act 72 on call of the Governor.

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(8) The commission shall:

74 (a) Determine the general type and nature of an
75 appropriate state memorial for those who lost their lives in
76 Mississippi as a result of Hurricane Katrina.

77 (b) Identify an appropriate site or sites for such a78 memorial.

(9) The commission may seek cooperation, advice and assistance from both private and governmental agencies and organizations, including local governments, learned societies, academic institutions, and historical, patriotic, philanthropic, civic, and professional groups and associations in carrying out its purpose.

85 The commission may solicit, accept, use and dispose of (10)86 any private or public funds in the form of donations of money, grants, property or personal services from individuals, 87 88 corporations and governments for purposes of the memorial. However, the commission shall first adopt rules and regulations 89 under which it may accept such donations or grants of money, 90 91 property or personal services, including the procedure for determining the value of the donation. 92 93 (11) The commission shall submit a report, not later than

94 December 1, 2007, to the Governor and the Legislature. The report S. B. No. 2366 * SS26/R26* 07/SS26/R26 PAGE 3 95 shall include recommendations for the type and nature of the 96 memorial and a site or sites for such memorial.

97 (12) All departments, commissions, boards, agencies,
98 officers and institutions of the state and all subdivisions
99 thereof shall cooperate with the commission in carrying out the
100 powers and purposes of this act.

101 (13) The commission shall be dissolved on December 31, 2008.
 102 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
 103 and after July 1, 2007.
