5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. The new office building for the Mississippi
7	Department of Employment Security, Office of the Governor, located
8	on Echelon Parkway in Jackson, Mississippi, shall be named and
9	known as the Clyde Kennard Building. The Department of Finance
10	and Administration shall prepare, or have prepared, a distinctive
11	plaque to be placed in a prominent place within the Clyde Kennard
12	Building, which states the background and service of the late
13	Clyde Kennard. Clyde Kennard was an African-American decorated
14	war Veteran and farmer who repeatedly tried to become the first
15	black student to enroll at the University of Southern Mississippi
16	(USM), and is remembered for his significant role in the history
17	of the civil rights movement in Mississippi.
18	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2007.
