## SENATE BILL NO. 2459

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-37-37, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
  TO REVISE THE ADDITIONAL TERM OF IMPRISONMENT FOR USE OF A FIREARM
  DURING COMMISSION OF ANOTHER FELONY BY A CONVICTED FELON; AND FOR

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 97-37-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 97-37-37. (1) Except to the extent that a greater minimum
- 9 sentence is otherwise provided by any other provision of law, any
- 10 person who uses or displays a firearm during the commission of any
- 11 felony shall, in addition to the punishment provided for such
- 12 felony, be sentenced to an additional term of imprisonment in the
- 13 custody of the Department of Corrections of five (5) years, which
- 14 sentence shall not be reduced or suspended.
- 15 (2) Except to the extent that a greater minimum sentence is
- 16 otherwise provided by any other provision of law, any convicted
- 17 felon who uses or displays a firearm during the commission of any
- 18 felony shall, in addition to the punishment provided for such
- 19 felony, be sentenced to an additional term of imprisonment in the
- 20 custody of the Department of Corrections of ten (10) years, to run
- 21 consecutively, not concurrently, which sentence shall not be
- 22 reduced or suspended.
- 23 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 2007.
