SENATE BILL NO. 2530

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-5-9, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REQUIRE ESTABLISHMENTS TO HAVE A LICENSE FROM THE BOARD OF BARBER 3 EXAMINERS BEFORE DISPLAYING BARBER SIGNS OR ADVERTISING BARBERING 4 SERVICES; TO AMEND SECTION 73-5-29, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 5 REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT OF LICENSE RENEWAL FEES FOR BARBERS AT 6 LEAST 80 YEARS OF AGE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** Section 73-5-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

10 73-5-9. No person shall practice or attempt to practice 11 barbering in the State of Mississippi without a certificate of 12 registration as a registered barber issued pursuant to the 13 provisions of this chapter.

14 No person shall be a barber instructor in the State of 15 Mississippi without a certificate of registration as a barber 16 instructor issued pursuant to the provisions of this chapter.

No establishment shall display a barber pole, barber sign or
 advertise barbering services unless it is licensed by the Board of
 Barber Examiners.

20 **SECTION 2.** Section 73-5-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 21 amended as follows:

22 73-5-29. The fee for taking an examination as a registered 23 barber shall be in the sum of not more than Fifty-five Dollars (\$55.00), and the further sum of not more than Thirty-five Dollars 24 25 (\$35.00) shall be required for the issuance of a certificate for the registered barber. The fee for taking an examination as a 26 27 registered barber instructor shall be in the sum of not more than Fifty-five Dollars (\$55.00), and the further sum of not more than 28 Forty Dollars (\$40.00) shall be required for the issuance of a 29 * SS26/ R803* S. certificate of registration for the registered barber instructor. 30 31 A fee of not more than One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) shall 32 be required for the issuance of a certificate of registration to a practicing barber of another state as authorized by Section 33 34 73-5-21. Likewise, an annual renewal fee payable on the 35 anniversary date of the issuance of each certificate of 36 registration as a registered barber of not more than Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) shall be charged for the issuance of the renewal 37 of the certificate; an annual renewal fee payable on the 38 39 anniversary date of the issuance of each certificate of registration as a registered barber instructor of not more than 40 Forty Dollars (\$40.00) shall be charged for the issuance of the 41 renewal of the certificate; however, the renewal fee for a 42 registered barber who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older 43 shall be not more than Thirty Dollars (\$30.00); no renewal fee 44 45 shall be charged to register barbers at least eighty (80) years of 46 A fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each year or any portion age. thereof in addition to payment of all unpaid renewal fees in 47 arrears and the regular renewal fee shall be required for the 48 49 restoration of expired certificates of registration issued 50 pursuant to this chapter. Additionally, in order to restore any 51 certificate of registration issued under this chapter that has 52 been expired for a period of five (5) years or longer, the holder 53 thereof must retake and pass the appropriate examination. А 54 penalty of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) in addition to payment of all unpaid renewal fees in arrears and the regular renewal fee shall 55 56 be required for the restoration of certificates that have expired 57 for a period of thirty (30) to sixty (60) days. A penalty of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) in addition to payment of all unpaid 58 59 renewal fees in arrears and the regular renewal fee shall be required for the restoration of certificates that have been 60 61 expired for a period greater than sixty (60) days.

However, each duplicate certificate issued shall have stamped across its face the word "duplicate" and shall bear the number of the original certificate in lieu of which it is issued.

68 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from69 and after July 1, 2007.
