## SENATE BILL NO. 2562

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-26-101, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO EXEMPT FROM MANAGEMENT TRAINING REQUIREMENTS THE BOARD MEMBERS 2 OF COMMUNITY PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS OPERATED BY MUNICIPALITIES WITH 3 A POPULATION GREATER THAN 10,000; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 41-26-101, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows: 41-26-101. (1) Each member elected or reelected after June 8 9 30, 1998, to serve on a governing board of any community public 10 water system, except systems operated by municipalities with a 11 population greater than ten thousand (10,000), shall attend a minimum of eight (8) hours of management training within two (2) 12 13 years following the election of that board member. Any member failing to complete the management training within two (2) years 14 15 after his election shall be subject to removal from the board by 16 the remaining members. If a board member has undergone training and is reelected to the board, that board member shall not be 17 required to attend training as provided by this subsection. 18

(2) The management training shall be organized by the State 19 Department of Health, in cooperation with the Mississippi Rural 20 21 Water Association and other organizations. The management 22 training shall include information on water system management and financing, rate setting and structures, operations and 23 24 maintenance, applicable laws and regulations, ethics, the duties and responsibilities of a board member and other information 25 26 deemed necessary by the department after consultation with the association and other organizations. 29 fee not to exceed Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) per member to 30 defray the actual costs of providing the materials and training. 31 These costs shall be reimbursed to the board member as an expense 32 of the community public water system.

33 (3) To avoid board members having to interfere with their 34 jobs or employment, management training sessions may be divided 35 into segments and, to the greatest extent possible, shall be 36 scheduled for evening sessions. The department shall conduct 37 management training on a regional basis and shall use community 38 college or other public facilities for the convenience of board 39 members.

40 (4) The department may make exceptions to and grant
41 exemptions and variances to the requirements of this section for
42 good cause shown.

43 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 44 and after July 1, 2007.
