SENATE BILL NO. 2583

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-5-177, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO GIVE ELECTRONIC 3 NOTICE OF RELEASE OF AN INMATE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 47-5-177, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

7 47-5-177. Within forty-eight (48) hours prior to the release of an offender from the custody of the department * * * because of 8 9 discharge, parole, pardon, temporary personal leave or pass, or otherwise, except for sickness or death in the offender's family, 10 11 the Director of Records of the department * * * shall give written or electronic notice of such release * * * to the sheriff of the 12 county and to the chief of police of the municipality where the 13 offender was convicted. If the offender is paroled to a county 14 other than the county of conviction, the Director of Records shall 15 give written or electronic notice of the release to the sheriff, 16 district attorney and circuit judge of the county and to the chief 17 of police of the municipality where the offender is paroled and to 18 the sheriff of the county and to the chief of police of the 19 municipality where the offender was convicted. The * * * 20 department * * * shall notify the parole officer of the county 21 where the offender is paroled or discharged to probation of any 2.2 chronic mental disorder incurred by the offender, of any type of 23 infectious disease for which the offender has been examined and 24 25 treated, and of any medications provided to the offender for such conditions. 26

The commissioner * * * shall require the Director of Records 27 to clearly identify the * * * notice of release of an offender who 28 has been convicted of arson at any time. The fact that the 29 offender to be released had been convicted of arson at any time 30 31 shall appear prominently on the notice of release and the sheriff shall notify all officials who are responsible for investigation 32 of arson within the county of such offender's release and the 33 chief of police shall notify all such officials within the 34 municipality of such offender's release. 35

36 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 37 and after its passage.
