## SENATE BILL NO. 2587

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 99-37-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 BY DELETING THE REPEALER ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF RESTITUTION 3 CENTERS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 99-37-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

7 99-37-19. The boards of supervisors of the several counties 8 and the governing authorities of municipalities are hereby 9 authorized to cooperate with the Department of Corrections in the establishment of restitution centers. Such centers may house both 10 11 probationers referred by the circuit courts as well as inmates transferred from other facilities of the Department of Corrections 12 as provided in Section 47-5-110. In order to qualify for 13 14 placement in a restitution center, an offender must: (a) be 15 convicted of a nonviolent offense that constitutes a felony, (b) not be convicted of a sex crime, and (c) not have drug, alcohol, 16 17 emotional or physical problems so serious that the offender appears unlikely to meet obligations of the restitution program. 18 Such centers shall be operated by the Department of Corrections. 19 20 County or municipal property may be utilized with the approval of the board of supervisors or municipal governing authority for the 21 construction, renovation and maintenance of facilities owned by 2.2 the state or a local political subdivision. Such facility may be 23 leased to the Department of Corrections for a period of time for 24 use as a restitution center. 25

It is the intent of this section that county and local governments contribute only to the establishment, renovation and

28 maintenance of the physical plant of a restitution center and that 29 the Department of Corrections support the operation of, and have 30 sole jurisdiction over and responsibility for offenders in, such 31 restitution program.

33 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 34 and after its passage.
