5	SECTION 1. Section 41-85-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6	amended as follows:
7	41-85-7. The administration of this chapter is vested in the
8	Mississippi Department of Health, which shall:
9	(a) Prepare and furnish all forms necessary under the

- provisions of this chapter in relation to applications for 10
- licensure or renewals thereof; 11
- 12 (b) Collect in advance at the time of filing an
- application for a license or at the time of renewal of a license a 13
- fee of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00); 14
- (i) A fee of Eighteen Dollars (\$18.00) per bed 15
- shall be levied for the review of inpatient hospice care; 16
- (ii) A fee to be determined by the Department 17
- 18 shall be levied for the review of inpatient hospice care plans by
- the department for proposed inpatient hospice care; 19
- (c) Conduct annual licensure inspections of all 20
- licensees which may be the same inspection as the annual Medicare 2.1
- certification inspection; and 22
- (d) Promulgate applicable rules and standards in 23
- furtherance of the purpose of this chapter and may amend such 24
- 25 rules as may be necessary. The rules shall include, but not be
