SENATE BILL NO. 2682

- AN ACT TO AMEND REENACTED SECTION 75-67-435, MISSISSIPPI CODE
- OF 1972, TO DELETE THE REPEALER ON THE PROVISION OF LAW WHICH AUTHORIZES THE COMMISSIONER OF BANKING AND CONSUMER FINANCE TO
- 4 EXAMINE BOOKS AND RECORDS OF LICENSEES UNDER THE TITLE PLEDGE ACT;
- 5 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 75-67-435, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 reenacted and amended as follows:
- 9 75-67-435. (1) The Commissioner of Banking and Consumer
- 10 Finance shall develop and provide any necessary forms to carry out
- 11 the provisions of this article.
- 12 (2) The department may adopt reasonable administrative
- 13 regulations, not inconsistent with law, for the enforcement of
- 14 this article.
- 15 (3) To assure compliance with the provision of this article,
- 16 the department may examine the books and records of any licensee
- 17 without notice during normal business hours. The commissioner may
- 18 charge the licensee an examination fee in an amount not less than
- 19 Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) nor more than Six Hundred Dollars
- 20 (\$600.00) for each office or location within the State of
- 21 Mississippi, plus any actual expenses incurred while examining the
- 22 licensee's records or books that are located outside the State of
- 23 Mississippi. However, in no event shall a licensee be examined
- 24 more than once in a two-year period unless for cause shown based
- 25 upon consumer complaint and/or other exigent reasons as determined
- 26 by the commissioner.
- 27 (4) On or before July 1, 2007, the commissioner shall file
- 28 with the Chairman of the Senate Business and Financial

- 29 Institutions Committee and the Chairman of the House Banking
- 30 Committee a report containing the total number of examinations or
- 31 audits of licensees conducted by the department for each year, the
- 32 total cost of such examinations, the number of examinations
- 33 grouped by range of costs, and any other information the
- 34 commissioner deems relevant to substantiate the examination fee
- 35 authorized in this section.
