SENATE BILL NO. 2720

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 45-35-3 AND 63-1-35, MISSISSIPPI 1 CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE SEX OFFENDERS TO OBTAIN A NEW DRIVER'S 2 LICENSE, PERMIT OR NONDRIVER'S IDENTIFICATION CARD THAT IDENTIFIES 3 4 THE INDIVIDUAL AS A SEX OFFENDER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 45-35-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 8 45-35-3. (1) Any person six (6) years of age or older may 9 be issued an identification card by the department which is 10 certified by the registrant and attested by the commissioner as to 11 true name, correct age and such other identifying data as required by Section 45-35-5. 12 (2) The new or renewal identification card of a person 13 14 required to register as a sex offender pursuant to Section 15 45-33-25 shall bear a designation identifying the cardholder as a 16 sex offender. SECTION 2. Section 63-1-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 17 amended as follows: 18 63-1-35. (1) The Commissioner of Public Safety shall 19 prescribe the form of licenses issued pursuant to this article 20 21 which shall, among other features, include a driver's license 22 number assigned by the Department of Public Safety which, at the option of the licensee, may or may not be the social security 23 24 number of the licensee. A licensee who chooses not to use his social security number as his driver's license number, except as 25 26 otherwise provided under subsection (2) of this section, shall list his social security number with the department which shall 27 28 cross reference the social security number with the driver's * SS01/ R600* S. license number for purposes of identification. Additionally, each 29 30 license shall bear a full face color photograph of the licensee in 31 such form that the license and the photograph cannot be separated. Such photograph shall be taken so that one (1) exposure will 32 33 photograph the applicant and the application simultaneously on the 34 same film. The department shall use a process in the issuance of 35 a license with a color photograph which shall prevent as nearly as possible any alteration, counterfeiting, duplication, 36

reproduction, forging or modification of such license or the 37 38 superimposition of a photograph without ready detection. Such photograph shall be replaced by the department at the time of 39 40 renewal. Driver licenses, including photographs appearing thereon, may be renewed by electronic means according to rules and 41 42 regulations promulgated by the commissioner. The Department of Public Safety may accept bank credit cards and debit cards in 43 44 payment of fees for driver license renewals that are processed by 45 electronic means and, if authorized by general law, may charge an additional fee for the use of such cards. 46

47 The commissioner shall prescribe the form of licenses (2)issued pursuant to this article to licensees who are not United 48 49 States citizens and who do not possess a social security number 50 issued by the United States government. The licenses of such 51 persons shall include a number and/or other identifying features. 52 (3) Any new or renewal driver's license, temporary driving 53 permit, intermediate license or commercial driver's license issued 54 to a person required to register as a sex offender pursuant to 55 Section 45-33-25 shall bear a designation identifying the licensee 56 or permittee as a sex offender.

57 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 58 and after July 1, 2007.
