## SENATE BILL NO. 2771

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9-9-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REVISE THE TIMING OF THE TERMS OF COURT FOR THE FIRST JUDICIAL 3 DISTRICT OF THE COUNTY COURT OF JONES COUNTY; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 9-9-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

8 9-9-19. (1) A term of court shall be held in the county 9 courthouse of the county, beginning on the second Monday of each 10 month and continuing so long as may be necessary; but in counties 11 where there are two (2) circuit court districts the county court shall meet alternately in the two (2) districts in the county 12 courthouse in the same month and in the same district as the board 13 of supervisors of said county holds its meetings. Provided that 14 in the County of Jones, a county having two (2) judicial 15 16 districts, that a term shall be held in the second judicial 17 district of said county on the second Monday of each month; and provided that in the first judicial district a term shall be held 18 on the fourth Monday of January, the fourth Monday of March, \* \* \* 19 the fourth Monday of June, the fourth Monday of September and the 20 21 first Monday of November. Provided that in the County of Hinds, a 22 county having two (2) judicial districts, a term shall be held in the first judicial district on the second Monday of each month and 23 24 in the second judicial district on the second Monday of March, June, September and December, and provided further that, when such 25 26 terms are held concurrently, either of the county judges of Hinds County may be assigned to hold all or any part of such terms in 27 28 either of the two (2) judicial districts. in the County of Bolivar, a county having two (2) judicial 29 30 districts, a term shall be held in the first judicial district on the second Monday of April, August and December, and in the second 31 judicial district on the second Monday of January, February, 32 33 March, May, June, July, September, October and November. 34 Provided, however, that in the County of Harrison, a county having two (2) county judges and two (2) judicial districts, that a term 35 shall be held in each judicial district concurrently each month. 36 Provided, however, that the judge of the county court for good 37 38 cause shown may, by order spread on the minutes of the county 39 court, designate some place other than the county courthouse for the holding of such term of the county court as may be designated 40 in said order. The county judge may call a special term of the 41 42 county court upon giving ten (10) days' notice, and such notice shall be given by posting the same at the front door of the 43 44 courthouse in said county and by the publication of said notice 45 for one insertion in some newspaper of general circulation in the 46 county.

(2) If a county court is established pursuant to an agreement between two (2) or more counties as provided in Section 9-9-3, the terms thereof shall remain continuously open and shall not be closed and the judge of such court shall sit in rotation in the county seat of each county, beginning on Monday of each week for at least a week in each county in each month.

53 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi 54 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor, 55 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the 56 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States 57 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the 58 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and 59 extended.
