## SENATE BILL NO. 2797

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-37-35, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO ENHANCE THE PENALTY FOR A CONVICTED FELON CONVICTED OF
- 3 POSSESSING A STOLEN FIREARM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 97-37-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 97-37-35. (1) It is unlawful for any person knowingly or
- 8 intentionally to possess, receive, retain, acquire or obtain
- 9 possession or dispose of a stolen firearm or attempt to possess,
- 10 receive, retain, acquire or obtain possession or dispose of a
- 11 stolen firearm.
- 12 (2) It is unlawful for any person knowingly or intentionally
- 13 to sell, deliver or transfer a stolen firearm or attempt to sell,
- 14 deliver or transfer a stolen firearm.
- 15 (3) Any person convicted of violating this section shall be
- 16 guilty of a felony and shall be punished as follows:
- 17 (a) (i) For the first conviction, punishment by
- 18 commitment to the Department of Corrections for five (5) years;
- 19 (ii) For the first conviction of a convicted
- 20 felon, punishment by commitment to the Department of Corrections
- 21 <u>for ten (10) years.</u>
- 22 (b) For the second and subsequent convictions, the
- 23 offense shall be considered trafficking in stolen firearms
- 24 punishable by commitment to the Department of Corrections for not
- 25 less than fifteen (15) years.
- 26 (c) For a conviction where the offender possesses two
- 27 (2) or more stolen firearms, the offense shall be considered

- 28 trafficking in stolen firearms punishable by commitment to the
- 29 Department of Corrections for not less than fifteen (15) years.
- 30 (4) Any person who commits or attempts to commit any other
- 31 crime while in possession of a stolen firearm shall be guilty of a
- 32 separate felony of possession of a stolen firearm under this
- 33 section and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by
- 34 commitment to the Department of Corrections for five (5) years,
- 35 such term to run consecutively and not concurrently with any other
- 36 sentence of incarceration.
- 37 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 38 and after July 1, 2007.
