SENATE BILL NO. 2805

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE IMPOSITION OF A \$1 SURCHARGE ON ALL
2 TRAFFIC TICKETS ISSUED IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES TO FUND
3 COMPUTERIZED CRIME PREVENTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** In addition to any other monetary penalties and
6 other penalties imposed by law, a municipality having a population
7 of one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) or more, according to the
8 most recent federal decennial census, may assess an additional
9 surcharge in an amount not to exceed One Dollar (\$1.00) for each
10 violation of Title 63 and offenses related to vehicular parking or
11 registration. The proceeds from the surcharge shall be dedicated
12 to the use of the municipal police department solely to offset the
13 cost of implementation of certain computerized crime prevention
14 measures and the equipment necessary therefor.

15 **SECTION 2.** This act shall be codified in Title 63, Chapter
16 9, Mississippi Code of 1972, relating to traffic violations
17 procedure.

18 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
19 and after July 1, 2007.
