COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2809

AN ACT TO REQUIRE AN INSURER PAYING A CLAIM FOR CERTAIN
DAMAGES UNDER A POLICY OF AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE TO PLACE ON THE
CHECK THE NAME OF ANY KNOWN LIENHOLDER OF THE AUTOMOBILE AS A LOSS
PAYEE IN ADDITION TO THE NAME OF THE INSURED; AND FOR RELATED
PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. An insurer paying a claim under automobile physical damage coverage or automobile collision coverage, as such terms are defined in Section 83-11-1, shall place on the check the name of any known lienholder of the automobile as a loss payee in addition to the name of the insured. An insurer shall reissue any check that does not comply with the provisions of this section.

15 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 16 and after July 1, 2007.
