- 1 AN ACT TO PLACE CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF ALL

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) No person shall operate an all terrain
- 6 vehicle on any public highway, street or road.
- 7 (2) No person shall operate or ride upon an all terrain
- 8 vehicle without wearing a crash helmet of the type and design
- 9 inspected and approved by the American Association of Motor
- 10 Vehicle Administrators.
- 11 (3) No more that one (1) person shall operate or ride upon
- 12 an all terrain vehicle designed for one (1) person.
- 13 (4) This section shall not apply to any law enforcement
- 14 officer, emergency personnel or fireman in the course of his
- 15 official duties.
- 16 (5) Any person convicted of a violation of this section
- 17 shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars
- 18 (\$100.00); for a second conviction within one (1) year of the
- 19 first conviction, the person shall be punished by a fine of not
- 20 more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00); for a third or subsequent
- 21 conviction, a person shall be punished by a fine of not more than
- 22 Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment for not more than
- 23 five (5) days, or both.
- 24 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 25 and after July 1, 2007.
