SENATE BILL NO. 2898

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND 1 2 PARKS TO TRANSFER AND CONVEY TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MARINE RESOURCES 3 CERTAIN STATE-OWNED REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE "LYMAN FISH 4 HATCHERY" AND LOCATED IN HARRISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS TO SELL 5 AND CONVEY CERTAIN STATE-OWNED REAL PROPERTY LOCATED NEAR U.S. 6 7 HIGHWAY 49 IN HARRISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AND TO DEPOSIT THE PROCEEDS FROM SUCH SALE INTO A NEWLY CREATED FUND KNOWN AS THE 8 "FISH HATCHERY SPECIAL FUND"; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 9

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** The Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks is hereby authorized to transfer and convey to the Department of Marine Resources certain state-owned real property, known as the "Lyman Fish Hatchery", located in Harrison County, Mississippi, and more specifically described as follows:

16 PARCEL ONE

(1) The Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and 37 Parks, acting through the Department of Finance and 38 Administration, is authorized to sell and convey certain 39 state-owned real property located near U.S. Highway 49 in Harrison 40 County, Mississippi, such land more specifically described as 41 follows:

created and known as the "Fish Hatchery Special Fund" to be used

(3) The land described in subsection (1) shall not be sold for less than the fair market value as determined by two (2) professional appraisers selected by the Department of Finance and Administration, who are certified general appraisers of the State of Mississippi.
