5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. Section 99-3-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

7 amended as follows:

- 8 99-3-39. (1) Boards of supervisors of the various counties
- 9 of this state and the governing authorities of the municipalities,
- 10 may either separately or in conjunction with each other, within
- 11 their discretion, offer monetary rewards, the amount of which
- shall be fixed by the aforesaid governing authorities, within 12
- 13 their discretion, for information leading to the apprehension of
- 14 any person subsequently convicted of any crime or misdemeanor
- 15 committed within this state; information regarding the whereabouts
- 16 of missing persons; the ascertaining or divulging of any
- 17 information necessary or helpful for the governing or the
- tranquility of any municipality or county of this state or for any 18
- like purpose, provided said reward shall not exceed the sum of 19
- Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) and provided further, 20
- 21 that said reward shall not be paid to any law enforcement officer
- or any employee of the governing authority offering such reward or 22
- any member of the immediate family of either. 23
- 24 (2) The aforesaid rewards may be paid from the general fund
