- 72 (2) The real property described in subsection (1) shall be 73 used by the State Board of Veterans Affairs as a state veterans 74 cemetery.
- 75 (3) If construction of a state veterans cemetery on the real 76 property described in subsection (1) has not commenced within ten 77 (10) years from the effective date of this act, then such property 78 shall revert to the State Board of Trustees for Institutions of 79 Higher Learning.
- 80 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 81 and after its passage.
