4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. Section 65-7-201, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6	amended as follows:
7	65-7-201. When any person shall desire to have a private
8	road laid out through the land of another, when necessary for
9	ingress and egress, he shall apply by petition, stating the facts
10	and reasons, to the special court of eminent domain created under
11	Section 11-27-3 of the county where the land or part of it is
12	located, and the case shall proceed as nearly as possible as
13	provided in Title 11, Chapter 27 for the condemnation of private
14	property for public use. The court sitting without a jury shall
15	determine the reasonableness of the application. The owner of the
16	property shall be a necessary party to the proceedings. If the
17	court finds in favor of the petitioner, the court shall select the
18	most direct and unobtrusive route for any private road granted
19	hereunder, taking into account cost, safety and any other factors
20	the court may deem relevant, all damages that the jury determines
21	the landowner should be compensated for shall be assessed against
22	and shall be paid by the person applying for the private road, and
23	he shall pay all the costs and expenses incurred in the
24	proceedings.

25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 26 and after its passage.
