SENATE BILL NO. 3083

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO HOWARD "BUTCH"  
2 NEWCOMB OF PRENTISS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Howard "Butch" Newcomb of Prentiss County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his  
7 conviction of the crime of receiving stolen property in 1991 in  
8 Prentiss County, Mississippi, and who was sentenced to serve  
9 twenty-four (24) months' probation under supervision of the  
10 Department of Corrections. His probation was terminated on  
11 January 29, 1992. Since that time, he has conducted himself as a  
12 law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

13 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
14 and after its passage.
