SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 13 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Governor's Office for the purpose of 14 15 defraying the expenses incurred by the Executive Department, being 16 the Governor's office and staff, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008.....\$ 17 651,810.00. SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 32 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 33 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for expenses incidental 34 to the proper operation of the Governor's Mansion and residence of 35 the Governor for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and 36 ending June 30, 2008...... \$ 722,731.00.

37 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of38 Section 4, the following positions are authorized:

Any escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

50 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that 51 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 52 53 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 54 55 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 56 57 made without competitive bids.

58 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 59 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 60 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 61 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal S.
