1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI GAMING COMMISSION, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Gaming Commission, for
9	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending
10	June 30, 2008\$ 3,757,205.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
14	Gaming Commission which are collected by or otherwise become
15	available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
16	Commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending
17	June 30, 2008\$ 6,722,852.00.
18	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
19	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
20	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
21	expenditure:

44	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
45	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
46	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
47	Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%)
48	whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.
49	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
50	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
51	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
52	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
53	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
54	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the
55	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
56	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
57	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
58	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
59	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
60	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
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cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal
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    Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
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    If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
    Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
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    has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
    projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services"
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    appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
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    reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
    requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
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    such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
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         Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
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    the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
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    allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
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    Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
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    approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
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    Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
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    approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
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    without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
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    appropriated level.
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         No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
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    used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
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    being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
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    act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
         The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise
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    award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
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    realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other
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    means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless
    specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of
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    teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the
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    next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an
    educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public
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    Accountant License or higher level professional certification as
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determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement

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- 94 of a departing employee with an individual from within state
- 95 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the
- 96 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,
- 97 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be
- 98 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise
- 99 authorized in this act.
- 100 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One
- 101 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is hereby authorized to be
- 102 transferred to the Mississippi Council on Compulsive Gambling, a
- 103 nonprofit organization.
- 104 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 105 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 106 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 107 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 108 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 109 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 110 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 111 made without competitive bids.
- 112 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 113 Mississippi Gaming Commission shall have the authority to escalate
- and expend funds from any proceeds arising from the participation
- in seizures of illegal gaming activities not to exceed One Hundred
- 116 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00).
- 117 **SECTION 7.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 118 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 119 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 120 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 121 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 122 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 123 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 124 and after July 1, 2007.
