SENATE BILL NO. 3134

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008. 2 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as 4 5 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the 6 7 expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 8 9 \$ 23,154,735.00. 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 11 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Development Authority or 12 the appropriate special fund for the purpose of defraying the 13 expenses incurred in the operation of the various divisions of the 14 15 authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending 16 June 30, 2008..... \$ 2,433,242,689.00. 17 SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized: 18 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 19 20 Permanent: Full Time.... 254 21 Part Time..... 2 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 2.2 30 23 Part Time..... 1 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation 24 25 Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation 26

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27 Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%)28 whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.

29 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 30 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 31 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 32 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 33 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the 34 35 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 36 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 37 38 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 39 act. 40 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 41 42 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 43 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 44 45 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 46 47 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 48 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 49 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 50 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 51 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 52 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 53 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 54

55 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 56 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written

56 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 57 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 58 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the

59 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

64 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 65 66 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 67 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 68 69 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 70 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 71 72 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 73 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement of a departing employee with an individual from within state 74 75 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 76 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 77 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 78 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 79 authorized in this act.

SECTION 4. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

121	SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the	
122	amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall	
123	be provided from the Mississippi Department of Transportation to	
124	defray the expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority in	
125	operating the state welcome centers.	

SECTION 6. The acceptance and expenditure of funds, and interest on such funds, received from, or by virtue of consent or other orders of or agreements involving any agency,

129 instrumentality, or judicial tribunal of any state or the United 130 States for petroleum price compliance and allocation which may 131 become available during the fiscal year for the support of the 132 Mississippi Development Authority or any programs sponsored under the terms of the receipt of these funds are hereby authorized not 133 to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and approved, 134 135 provided such receipts and expenditures are reported and otherwise 136 accounted for in accordance with Section 27-103-101 et seq., and 137 Section 27-104-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Development Authority is hereby authorized to escalate, budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

144 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 145 Mississippi Development Authority shall maintain complete 146 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 147 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 148 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 149 Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 150 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be 151 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 152 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 153 provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.

SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, the amount of Six Million Four Hundred Sixty-two Thousand Dollars (\$6,462,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism Advertising and Promotion, and shall not be expended for any type

of cultural exchange program. The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, the amount of One Million Five Hundred Sixty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$1,567,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is provided for the purpose of supporting, marketing, and facilitating Mississippi business growth. The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 11. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds for Mississippi Technology Alliance, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008.....

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177 The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section 178 are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for 179 support of Mississippi Technology Alliance to strengthen the 180 business environment in Mississippi to spur the creation and 181 growth of technology-based industries, thus creating many more 182 high-paying jobs and a more diversified, competitive Mississippi 183 economy. The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi 184 185 Development Authority.

186 SECTION 12. In addition to all other sums herein 187 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 188 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 189 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi 190 Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds to 191 support the Enterprise for Geospatial Solutions, for the

192 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008...

The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi Development Authority.

197 SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that of 198 the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, not more than Twenty 199 Thousand (\$20,000.00) may be expended for Mississippi Development 200 Authority employee travel associated with business recruitment 201 activities conducted at the Mississippi event located in New York 202 City's Central Park.

SECTION 14. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 203 204 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 205 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 206 are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 207 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 208 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 209 210 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 211 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following 212 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 213 Mississippi State Legislature."

214 SECTION 15. In addition to all other sums herein 215 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 216 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 217 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Telecommunication 218 Conference and Training Center Fund #3424, for the purpose of 219 defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Telecommunication Conference and Training Center Commission, for the fiscal year 220 221 beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 222\$ 2,116,299.00. 223

The funds appropriated in this section shall be derived from any revenues collected by the commission from fees, rates or

225 charges for the use of the Telecommunication Conference and 226 Training Center, as authorized in Section 31-31-9, Mississippi 227 Code of 1972.

Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of this section, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of expenditure.

254	SECTION 16. Of the funds appropriated in Section 15, the	
255	following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby	
256	appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit	ī
257	of the Mississippi Telecommunication Conference and Training	
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Facility Reserve Fund #3425, to the Mississippi Telecommunication 258 259 Conference and Training Center Commission for the purpose of 260 paying debt service and maintaining, renovating, improving or 261 making additions to the Telecommunication Conference and Training 262 facility for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending 263 June 30, 2008..... \$ 737,934.00.

264 It is the intention of the Legislature that not more than 265 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) of the funds 266 appropriated in this section shall be used by the commission for 267 the maintenance and operation of the facility, provided that this 268 sum of money remains available in the fund after transferring amounts to the State Treasurer to pay debt service, as prescribed 269 270 in Section 31-31-11(5), Mississippi Code of 1972.

271 SECTION 17. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 272 273 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 274 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 275 276 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 277 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 278 made without competitive bids.

279 SECTION 18. It is legislative intent to ensure beneficial 280 information reaches as many Mississippians as possible. Further, 281 it is legislative intent that the expenditure of public funds for 282 this purpose be accomplished in an efficient and effective manner. 283 Therefore, state agencies as standard procedure, will observe 284 the following criteria:

Develop goals and desired result for a campaign. 286 (2) Evaluate effectiveness through respected advertising 287 standards, including market reach and cost effectiveness.

288 (3) Seek public service announcements, which would be aired 289 by media without cost.

(4) Itemize and justify professional assistance and related
expenses for creative and production costs outside of the actual
media expenditures.

293 (5) Utilize Mississippi owned media companies when feasible. 294 SECTION 19. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 295 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 296 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 297 298 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 299 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 300 SECTION 20. This act shall take effect and be in force from 301 and after July 1, 2007.
