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         With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
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    the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
    make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
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    Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
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    funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
    are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
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    Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
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    Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
    determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
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    appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
          It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
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    that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
    cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriations for "Personal
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    Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds
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    and educational benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any
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    action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board
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    determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause
    the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year
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    2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then
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    only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or
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    the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State
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    Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this

- 81 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 82 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 83 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 84 made without competitive bids.
- 85 **SECTION 6.** It is legislative intent to ensure beneficial
- 86 information reaches as many Mississippians as possible. Further,
- 87 it is legislative intent that the expenditure of public funds for
- 88 this purpose be accomplished in an efficient and effective manner.
- Therefore, state agencies as standard procedure, will observe
- 90 the following criteria:

- 105 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 106 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 107 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 108 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 109 and after July 1, 2007.
