1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI NATIONAL GUARD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the general expenses of the operation of the Mississippi
9	National Guard for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and
10	ending June 30, 2008\$ 8,403,302.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Mississippi National
13	Guard, out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the
14	Camp Shelby Timber Fund-No. 3700, as created by Chapter 187, Laws
15	of 1954, as amended; the Army National Guard Programs Fund-No.
16	3701; the Camp Shelby Base Operations Fund-No. 3705; and the Air
17	National Guard Programs Fund-No. 3709, for the purpose of carrying
18	out the provisions of applicable statutes and federal/state
19	agreements for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending
20	June 30, 2008\$ 49,114,616.00.
21	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
22	of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

    agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to
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    the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
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    detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
    during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.
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         SECTION 5. All funds authorized to be expended herein shall
    be expended and otherwise accounted for in accordance with the
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    provisions of Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.
    If not needed for other purposes, the Adjutant General is hereby
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    expressly authorized to invest any part of or all monies herein
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    appropriated out of the Camp Shelby Timber Fund at the highest
    rate of interest obtainable and credit interest accruing on such

    and approved, provided such expenditures are reported and
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    otherwise handled in accordance with the state budget law, same
    being Section 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.
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- 61 **SECTION 7.** The acceptance and expenditure of federal funds
- 62 which may become available to the Mississippi National Guard for
- 63 construction purposes is hereby authorized and approved, provided
- 64 such receipts and expenditures are reported and otherwise handled
- 65 in accordance with the state budget law, same being Section
- 66 27-103-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 67 **SECTION 8.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Two
- 68 Million Sixty-four Thousand Five Hundred Sixteen Dollars
- 69 (\$2,064,516.00) shall be provided for the support of the Youth
- 70 Challenge Program at Camp Shelby.
- 71 **SECTION 9.** It is legislative intent to ensure beneficial
- 72 information reaches as many Mississippians as possible. Further,
- 73 it is legislative intent that the expenditure of public funds for
- 74 this purpose be accomplished in an efficient and effective manner.
- 75 Therefore, state agencies as standard procedure, will observe
- 76 the following criteria:
- 77 (a) Develop goals and desired result for a campaign.
- 78 (b) Evaluate effectiveness through respected
- 79 advertising standards, including market reach and cost
- 80 effectiveness.
- 81 (c) Seek public service announcements, which would be
- 82 aired by media without cost.
- 83 (d) Itemize and justify professional assistance and
- 84 related expenses for creative and production costs outside of the
- 85 actual media expenditures.
- 86 (e) Utilize Mississippi-owned media companies when
- 87 feasible.
- 88 **SECTION 10.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of
- 89 this act, an amount not to exceed Six Hundred Nine Thousand Two
- 90 Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$609,216.00) is provided for the Armed
- 91 Forces Military Museum located at Camp Shelby.
- 92 **SECTION 11.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 93 Mississippi Military Department shall have the authority to

- 94 receive, budget and expend funds from any source that may become
- 95 available to the Department in the Camp Shelby Base Operations
- Fund, fund number 3705, and the Camp Shelby Timber Fund, fund 96
- 97 number 3700, in an amount not to exceed Ten Million Dollars
- 98 (\$10,000,000.00) in accordance with the rules and regulations of
- 99 the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner
- consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 100
- SECTION 12. Of the funds provided under the provisions of 101
- this act, an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Dollars 102
- 103 (\$300,000.00) is provided for the Sonny Montgomery Center for
- 104 American's Veterans at Mississippi State University.
- 105 SECTION 13. The department is authorized to expend available
- 106 funds on technology or equipment upgrades or replacements when it
- 107 will generate savings through efficiency or when the savings
- generated from such upgrades or replacements exceed expenditures 108
- 109 thereof.
- 110 SECTION 14. It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 111 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 112 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 113 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 114 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 115 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 116 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 117 made without competitive bids.
- SECTION 15. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 118
- the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 119
- 120 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 121 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 122 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 123 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 16. This act shall take effect and be in force from
