162	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
163	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
164	Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%)
165	whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.
166	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
167	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
168	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
169	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
170	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
171	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the
172	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
173	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
174	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
175	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
176	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure

180	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
181	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
182	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
183	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services"
184	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
185	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
186	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
187	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
188	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
189	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
190	allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
191	Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
192	approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
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- 193 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 194 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 195 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 196 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 198 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 199 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 200 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 201 **SECTION 4.** The Commissioner of Public Safety may, on a
- 202 case-by-case basis, within funds available, recommend that
- 203 corrective salary adjustments be made to the compensation of
- 204 employees of the Department of Public Safety where an inequity was
- 205 created between employees of equivalent capacity by previous
- 206 application of the agency appropriation acts. Any such corrective
- 207 salary adjustment plan must have prior approval by the State
- 208 Personnel Board. Such adjustments will not be retroactive.
- 209 Any funds in the Salary, Wages and Fringe Benefits major
- 210 object of expenditure may be used to purchase accumulated
- 211 compensatory time within funds available.
- 212 SECTION 5. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall have the
- 213 authority to transfer both positions and/or State General Funds
- 214 appropriated herein from any Division within the Department of
- 215 Public Safety to any other Division within the Department of
- 216 Public Safety, not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%).
- 217 **SECTION 6.** It is the intent of the Legislature that the
- 218 local governments pay for part of the computer cost of the
- 219 Mississippi Justice Information Center by maintaining their
- 220 contribution to the Department of Public Safety.
- 221 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 222 Department of Public Safety designate certain employees to aid the
- 223 Division of Crime Laboratories in the billing and collecting of
- 224 all fees charged for services rendered by the Division of Crime
- 225 Laboratories.

- SECTION 8. No part of the funds appropriated herein shall be 226 227 transferred to, expended by, or used, directly or indirectly, for 228 the benefit of any public relations, publicity or publication 229 activities of any other state agency, department or officer, nor 230 shall any personnel paid with funds appropriated herein be 231 transferred or assigned to any other state agency, department or 232 officer for public relations, publicity, or publication activities 233 of such office.
- SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
  Department of Public Safety shall have the authority to receive,
  budget and expend funds from any source in accordance with the
  rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
  Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
  federal funds.
- 240 **SECTION 10.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 241 Department of Public Safety shall not issue citations for 242 violations of speed limits on a quota basis. No funds expended 243 under this act shall be used for such quota-based citations for 244 violations of speed limits.
- 245 SECTION 11. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall have the authority to transfer Department of Public Safety Special Funds 246 247 from any Division within the Department of Public Safety to any 248 other Division of the Department of Public Safety Special Funds, 249 including, but not limited to, Funds 3711, 371C, 371E, 3713, 3714, 250 3715, 3740, 3741, 3742, 3744, 3747 and 3718, not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) collectively during Fiscal Year 251 252 2008. Further, the Department of Public Safety shall be 253 authorized to escalate both funds and positions for any special fund monies received for Homeland Security. 254
- SECTION 12. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance

  Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of

  the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized

  in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the

- 403 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 405 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 23. This act shall take effect and be in force from 406 407 and after July 1, 2007, except for Section 20 which shall take 408 effect and be in force from and after its passage.

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
