1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE BOARD OF ARCHITECTURE AND LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Architecture and
8	Landscape Architecture Advisory Committee, for the purpose of
9	defraying the expenses incurred by said board for the fiscal year
10	beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
11	\$ 323,504.00.
12	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
13	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
15	Permanent: Full Time 2
16	Part Time0
17	Time-Limited: Full Time
18	Part Time0
19	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
20	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
21	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
22	Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever
23	is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.
24	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
25	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
26	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
27	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008

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    funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
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    are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
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    Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
    Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
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    determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
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    appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
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    act.
          It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
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    that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
    cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriations for "Personal
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    Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds
    and educational benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any
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    action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board
    determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause
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    the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year
    2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then
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    only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or
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    the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State
    Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this
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    provision are met. On January 1, 2008, the State Personnel Board
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    will make adjustments to the structure side of the compliance
    report based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office in
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    order for agencies to award educational benchmarks.
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         Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
    the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
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    allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
    Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
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    approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
    Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
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    approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
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    without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
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    appropriated level.
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         No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
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used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

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- 61 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 62 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 63 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 64 Board of Architecture shall maintain complete accounting and
- 65 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 66 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 67 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 68 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 69 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to
- 70 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 71 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 72 during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.
- 73 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 74 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 75 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 76 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 77 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 78 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 79 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 80 made without competitive bids.
- 81 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 82 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 83 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 84 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 85 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 86 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 87 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 88 and after July 1, 2007.
