SENATE BILL NO. 3151 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF BANKING AND CONSUMER FINANCE 2 3 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 6 7 State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Banking 8 and Consumer Finance, for the support of the State Department of Banking and Consumer Finance, for the fiscal year beginning 9 July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 10 11 \$ 7,041,799.00. SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions 12 13 of Section 1, the following positions are authorized: AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 14 15 Permanent: Full Time..... 59 Part Time..... 16 0 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 17 0 18 Part Time..... 0 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation 19 20 Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation 21 Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever 2.2 is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007. 23 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 24 25 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 26 27 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008

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28 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 29 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 30 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 31 32 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 33 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 34 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 35 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriations for "Personal 36 37 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds and educational benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any 38 39 action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause 40 41 the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then 42 43 only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or 44 the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this 45 provision are met. On January 1, 2008, the State Personnel Board 46 47 will make adjustments to the structure side of the compliance report based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office in 48 49 order for agencies to award educational benchmarks.

50 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 51 52 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 53 54 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 55 56 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 57 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 58 appropriated level.

59 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 60 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are S. B. No. 3151 * SS02/A512SG*

07/SS02/A512SG PAGE 2 61 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 62 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

63 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 64 Department of Banking and Consumer Finance shall maintain complete 65 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 66 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 67 Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 68 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be 69 70 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 71 provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process. 72

73 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 74 Department of Banking and Consumer Finance shall have the 75 authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from any source 76 received from the Office of the Attorney General in an amount not 77 to exceed Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) in accordance 78 with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and 79 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 80 federal funds.

It is the intention of the Legislature that 81 SECTION 5. 82 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 83 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 84 85 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 86 87 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids. 88

89 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 90 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 91 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 92 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
