## SENATE BILL NO. 3158

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE STATE TREASURY TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI MOTOR 2 3 VEHICLE COMMISSION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 6 7 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Motor Vehicle Commission, as provided by Section 63-17-51 et seq., Mississippi 8 Code of 1972, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said 9 Commission, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending 10 11 June 30, 2008.....\$ 291,222.00. **SECTION 2.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 12 13 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 14 expenditure: 15 MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 16 Personal Services: 17 18 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 199,208.00 Travel and Subsistence..... 19 25,000.00 Contractual Services..... 20 58,014.00 21 Commodities..... 6,000.00 2.2 Capital Outlay: 0.00 Other Than Equipment..... 23 3,000.00 24 Equipment..... Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%) whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.

39 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 40 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 41 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 42 43 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 44 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the 45 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 46 47 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 48 49 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 50 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 51 52 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 53 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 54 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 55 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 56 57 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 58 59 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 60 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

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Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 61 62 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 63 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 64 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 65 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 66 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 67 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 68 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 69 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

74 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 75 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 76 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 77 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 78 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 79 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 80 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 81 82 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 83 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement of a departing employee with an individual from within state 84 85 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 86 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 87 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 88 89 authorized in this act.

90 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 91 of the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act shall 92 be expended to defray any expenses of the Motor Vehicle Commission 93 if said commission takes any official actions during Fiscal Year S. No. 3158 \*SS05/A839\* 07/SS05/A839 PAGE 3 94 2008 that serve directly or indirectly to reduce the payment to 95 the State General Fund of any sales tax on motor vehicles sold 96 within the State of Mississippi.

97 It is further the intention of the Legislature that if such 98 actions are taken by the Motor Vehicle Commission during Fiscal 99 Year 2008, the executive director and commission members shall be 100 held personally liable for repayment of any funds expended under the provisions of this act with said repayment to be made to the 101 State General Fund. The Attorney General is hereby authorized and 102 103 directed to undertake appropriate legal action to enforce the 104 provisions of this act and to recover said funds.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 105 106 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 107 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 108 109 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 110 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 111 112 made without competitive bids.

113 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 114 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 115 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 116 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 117 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 118 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 119 120 and after July 1, 2007.

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
