Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.

39 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 40 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 41 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 42 43 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 44 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 45 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 46 47 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 48 49 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 50 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriations for "Personal 51 52 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds and educational benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any 53 54 action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause 55 the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 56 57 2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or 58 59 the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this 60 * SS26/ A839SG* S. 07/SS26/A839SG PAGE 2 61 provision are met. On January 1, 2008, the State Personnel Board 62 will make adjustments to the structure side of the compliance 63 report based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office in 64 order for agencies to award educational benchmarks.

65 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 67 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 68 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 69 The 70 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 71 72 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 73 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act shall be expended to defray any expenses of the Motor Vehicle Commission if said commission takes any official actions during Fiscal Year 2008 that serve directly or indirectly to reduce the payment to the State General Fund of any sales tax on motor vehicles sold within the State of Mississippi.

85 It is further the intention of the Legislature that if such actions are taken by the Motor Vehicle Commission during Fiscal 86 87 Year 2008, the executive director and commission members shall be held personally liable for repayment of any funds expended under 88 89 the provisions of this act with said repayment to be made to the 90 State General Fund. The Attorney General is hereby authorized and 91 directed to undertake appropriate legal action to enforce the 92 provisions of this act and to recover said funds.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 93 94 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 95 96 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 97 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 98 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 99 100 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 5.
