1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE CENTENNIAL OF UNITED
2 PARCEL SERVICE OF AMERICA, INC., (UPS) AND THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF
3 THE COMPANY TO THE CITIZENS OF MISSISSIPPI.

4 WHEREAS, on August 28, 2007, United Parcel Service will
5 celebrate its 100th Anniversary; and

6 WHEREAS, UPS has served Mississippi since 1971 and today
7 employs over 3,100 employees and operates 22 facilities across the
8 state; and

9 WHEREAS, each day, 8,000 citizens of Mississippi utilize the
10 express delivery and specialized transportation and logistics
11 services that UPS provides; and

12 WHEREAS, UPS delivers more than 111,000 packages every day to
13 customers across Mississippi, connecting people, communities and
14 businesses; and

15 WHEREAS, the services UPS provides connects the people of
16 Mississippi to more than 200 countries through its expansive
17 transportation network that truly synchronizes global commerce;

19 WHEREAS, UPS has contributed more than \$810,000.00 to
20 philanthropic endeavors in the State of Mississippi since 1995,
21 reflecting the company's emphasis on community service and
22 citizenship; and

23 WHEREAS, UPS will continue to both provide a substantial
24 economic impact to the people of Mississippi and focus on
25 cultivating deep partnerships with the communities it serves:

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
27 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
