- 5 WHEREAS, after a distinguished career of public service and
- 6 stewardship of the environment and Mississippi's natural
- 7 resources, Charles H. Chisolm has announced his retirement as
- 8 Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental
- 9 Quality; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Charles Howard Chisolm was born and raised near
- 11 Meridian, Mississippi. He graduated from Center Hill High School
- 12 in 1961 and from East Central Community College in 1963. He
- 13 graduated from Mississippi State University in 1966 with a
- 14 Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering and in 1968 with
- 15 an M.S. in Environmental Engineering: and
- WHEREAS, he worked with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in
- 17 Vicksburg, Mississippi, in 1966-1967 and with U.S. Steel in
- 18 Birmingham, Alabama, in 1969; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he has worked in the Mississippi environmental
- 20 protection programs since August 1969, having served in various
- 21 positions, including Director of the Office of Pollution Control
- 22 from 1977-1999. Since 2000, he has served as Executive Director
- 23 of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality. The
- 24 department is responsible for protecting the state's environment.
- 25 It administers most of the U.S. EPA programs, including air, water
- 26 and waste management activities; monitors, models and regulates
- 27 water use; and functions as the State Geological Survey; and

WHEREAS, he is a member of the Mississippi Agricultural 28 29 Aviation Board and has served as chairman of that board. He is 30 Chairman of the Mississippi Coordinating Council for Remote Sensing and Geographic Information Systems. In 2001, he served as 31 32 Chairman of the Governor's Water and Sewer Task Force. 33 currently a member of several other state boards; and 34 WHEREAS, Mr. Chisolm has been licensed as a Professional 35 Engineer in Mississippi since 1970; and WHEREAS, he has been recognized by the Mississippi State 36 37 University College of Engineering as a Distinguished Engineering He was given the "2005 Award for Excellence in 38 Environmental and Resources Stewardship" by the American Bar 39 Association's Section of Environment, Energy and Resources. 40 He has received the 2004 "Engineer of the Year Award" from the 41 Mississippi Engineering Society and also the 2003 "Conservationist 42 43 of the Year Award (Governor's Award) " from The Mississippi 44 Wildlife Federation; and WHEREAS, he and his wife, Nikki, have been married for 40 45 years and reside in Brandon, Mississippi. Their son, Eric, lives 46 47 in Los Alamos, New Mexico; and WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the many 48 49 years of selfless service by this dedicated public servant who 50 leaves a legacy of protecting Mississippi's environment: NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF 51 52 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That we do hereby commend the dedicated career and legacy of 53 54 environmental stewardship of Charles H.
