SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 587

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE WEEK OF APRIL 1-7,
2 2007, AS "JUNIOR AUXILIARY WEEK" IN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI.
