## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 589

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REMEMBERING THE GALLANT SERVICE AND 2 COMMENDING THE LIFE OF UNITED STATES ARMY SERGEANT 1ST CLASS WILLIAM C. SPILLERS OF TERRY, MISSISSIPPI, WHO DIED IN IRAQ ON 3 4 FEBRUARY 17, 2007, AND EXPRESSING THE SYMPATHY OF THE LEGISLATURE. 5 WHEREAS, United States Army Sergeant 1st Class William 6 Spillers, 39, of Terry, Mississippi, died in Baghdad, Iraq, on Saturday, February 17, 2007; and 7 8 WHEREAS, Sergeant Spillers was a full-time soldier with the 9 Mississippi National Guard. He worked at the Joint Forces Headquarters in Jackson, Mississippi, and was assigned to the 10 11 Jackson-based 230th Finance Detachment. Twenty-one members of the unit were mobilized in May 2006, and arrived in Iraq in August 12 2006; and 13 14 WHEREAS, carried by an Army Honor Guard, he returned to his former home and to his wife and family, and to his community. He 15 16 was buried with full military honors on Sunday, February 25, 2007, 17 at Autumn Woods Memorial Gardens; and WHEREAS, according to General Harold Cross, Adjutant General 18 19 of the Mississippi National Guard, Sergeant Spillers was a model soldier, who was always attentive to his duties and had many 20 21 friends in his unit; and WHEREAS, since operations began in Iraq and Afghanistan, at 22 23 least 47 soldiers or sailors with Mississippi ties have died in 24 action; and WHEREAS, William Spillers was a loving husband who is counted 25 among America's heroes, committed to our nation's safety and 26 security. To a country, a fallen soldier means a national loss; 27
