- 6 defeated New Hope 74-69 in a gutsy come-from-behind victory on

- 8 Championship before a crowd of 4,200 at the Mississippi Coliseum;

- 10 WHEREAS, Coach Thomas Billups' success at Lanier High School
- 11 may be unmatched in the history of Mississippi high school boys
- 12 basketball. Years from now, fans will talk about the day Coach
- 13 Billups won his 500th victory, his MHSAA-record eighth Boys State
- 14 Title and his third in a row at the Mississippi Coliseum. In 16
- 15 seasons, Billups has coached in 13 State Finals, including 9 in a

39	enough) after his team's convincing 59-47 victory over archrival

41	champions in 25 years before an announced crowd of 1,599 at the			
42	BancorpSouth Arena on Saturday, March 17, 2007. Dandy Dozen			
43	Senior R.L. Horton capped one of the winningest careers in
