SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 618

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE CENTENNIAL 2 ANNIVERSARY OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF UNITED PARCEL SERVICE OF AMERICA, INC. (UPS) AND THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE COMPANY TO THE 3 CITIZENS OF MISSISSIPPI. 4 5 WHEREAS, the 100th Anniversary of United Parcel Service 6 recognizes and celebrates the contributions of UPS to the people of Mississippi, both economically and philanthropically; and 7 WHEREAS, on August 28, 2007, United Parcel Service of 8 9 America, Inc. (UPS) will celebrate its 100th Anniversary. Over the past 100 years, the world has witnessed the transformation of 10 11 UPS from a single-city bicycle messenger company into the world's largest package delivery company; and 12 13 WHEREAS, UPS was founded in Seattle as a messenger service in 1907 by a 19-year-old teenager who borrowed \$100.00 to start the 14 15 service. Over the subsequent 100 years, much of it guided by 16 founder Jim Casey, UPS transformed itself into a department store 17 delivery service; a common carrier offering package delivery service throughout the United States; an international package 18 delivery service with its own airline and now, a trusted business 19 partner that literally enables commerce for its customers by 20 21 synchronizing the flow of goods, information and money; and 22 WHEREAS, UPS employs more than 427,000 people; operates the world's largest package delivery network; operates the planet's 23 24 eighth-largest airline; utilizes almost 92,000 vehicles; and offers an ever-expanding array of supply chain services. UPS has 25 26 transformed its organization dramatically, from a company primarily focused on package delivery in the United States to a 27 28 broader provider of transportation-based and supply chain * SS02/ R1498* S. 29 services. UPS today stands as a critical pipeline for global 30 economic activity; and

31 WHEREAS, UPS is the world's largest package delivery company 32 and a global leader in supply chain services, offering an 33 extensive range of options for synchronizing the movement of 34 goods, information and funds. UPS is headquartered in Atlanta, 35 Georgia, and serves more than 200 countries and territories 36 worldwide; and

WHEREAS, UPS has served Mississippi since 1971. In Mississippi, UPS employs more than 2,200 people and operates 22 package sorting facilities. UPS makes more than 75,000 package deliveries each business day in Mississippi, connecting people, communities and businesses; and

42 WHEREAS, UPS donates thousands of dollars annually to 43 organizations, including the Mississippi Food Network and The 44 United Way, reflecting the company's emphasis on community service 45 and citizenship; and

46 WHEREAS, UPS donated \$1.25 Million to assist Hurricane 47 Katrina relief efforts for Mississippi and Gulf Coast residents; 48 and

WHEREAS, UPS will continue to both provide a substantial economic impact to the people of Mississippi and focus on cultivating deep partnerships with the communities it serves. The services UPS provides connect the people of Mississippi to more than 200 countries through an expansive transportation network that truly synchronizes global commerce; and

55 WHEREAS, UPS has grown from a \$100.00 firm in 1907 to a \$47 56 Billion company last year. A key factor in UPS's success has been 57 a willingness to transform -- from a ground company to an air 58 express company -- from a U.S. company to an international company 59 -- from a paper-based company to a hi-tech company and now, from a 50 shipping company to a global supply chain company; and
