## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 633

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE  
2 MURRAH HIGH SCHOOL "LADY MUSTANGS" AND HEAD COACH ANNA JACKSON FOR  
3 WINNING THE CLASS 5A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP AND FOR THEIR EXCELLENT  
4 2006-2007 SEASON WHICH INCLUDED THE MOST VICTORIES IN SCHOOL  
5 HISTORY.

6 WHEREAS, the tradition-rich Murrah High School "Lady  
7 Mustangs" made history when they recorded the 37th victory of the  
8 season, the most in school annals. Murrah used a quick 7-minute  
9 third-quarter outburst to dismantle Coldwater 59-39 in the  
10 semifinals of the Mississippi High School Activities Association  
11 Grand Slam before an announced crowd of 1,673 at BancorpSouth  
12 Arena in Tupelo. This was the Lady Mustangs' 21st straight  
13 victory; and

14 WHEREAS, Murrah, No. 1 in *The Clarion-Ledger* Super 10 and No.  
15 14 in the nation by *USA Today*, faced No. 2 Gentry (39-0) in the  
16 title game, but fell short and ended the 2006-2007 season with an  
17 impressive record of 32-2; and

18 WHEREAS, Head Coach Anna V. Jackson won her 600th game  
19 November 9, 2006. Her career record is 634-163, and she has won 7  
20 Class 5A State Titles; and

21 WHEREAS, the Lady Mustangs' tournament record is as follows:  
22 participated in the Sharp Impression Tournament in Bossier City,  
23 Louisiana; JPS/Pepsi Champions; Division 4-5A Champions; North  
24 State 5A Champions; and State 5A Champions; and

25 WHEREAS, the following team members received individual  
26 honors: Brandi Simmons: All-Division 4-5A, All-JPS/Pepsi and  
27 All-State 5A; Tanecka Carey: All-Division 4-5A, All-JPS/Pepsi and  
28 All-State 5A; LaShondra Barrett: Dandy Dozen, MVP JPS/Pepsi

29 Tournament; MVP Division 4-5A Tournament and All-State 5A; and  
30 Janice Okeke received the Cellular South Scholar Athlete Award,  
31 presented at the State Tournament; and

32 WHEREAS, the 2006-2007 Lady Mustangs team roster is as  
33 follows: Lashondra Barrett (11), Jordan Henley (11), Brandi  
34 Simmons (10), Madison Nevels (10), Kierra Dampier (10), Chastidy

39 Ashley Trussell; Tyler Gibson; and Gwen Davis; and

40 WHEREAS, Head Coach Anna V. Jackson and Assistant Coaches  
41 Dakedreon Lampkin and Frank Ward made the following remarks about  
42 this championship season: "The Lady Mustangs are a very young,  
43 talented team and played a very tough schedule -- most of the  
44 games were played on the road. We ended the season ranked No. 1  
45 in the state, No. 16 in the nation and in the final *The*  
46 *Clarion-Ledger* poll was ranked No. 2 in the state"; and

47 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the special  
48 achievement of this group of student athletes who have brought  
49 honor to their school, their community and to the State of  
50 Mississippi:

51 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF  
52 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That  
53 we do hereby commend and congratulate the Murrah High School "Lady  
54 Mustangs" and Head Coach Anna V. Jackson for winning the Class 5A  
55 State Championship and for their excellent 2006-2007 season which  
56 included the most victories in school history, and extend to them  
57 the best wishes of the Legislature on their future athletic and  
58 academic successes.
