## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 643

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE  
2 PURPOSE OF REQUESTING THE DRAFTING, INTRODUCTION, CONSIDERATION  
3 AND PASSAGE OF A BILL ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-65-101,  
4 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT FROM AND AFTER JANUARY  
5 1, 2006, SALES OF COMPONENT MATERIALS USED IN THE REPLACEMENT OR  
6 REPAIR OF CERTAIN BUILDINGS DESTROYED OR DAMAGED AS A RESULT OF A  
7 DISASTER DECLARED BY THE GOVERNOR AND SALES OF CERTAIN MACHINERY  
8 OR EQUIPMENT USED TO REPLACE MACHINERY OR EQUIPMENT DAMAGED OR  
9 DESTROYED AS A RESULT OF SUCH DISASTER SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM ALL OR  
10 A PORTION OF THE SALES TAX; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE  
12 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That the Joint Rules  
13 of the Senate and the House are hereby suspended for the purpose  
14 of requesting the drafting, introduction, consideration and  
15 passage, regardless of any deadlines imposed by said rules, of a  
16 bill entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-65-101, MISSISSIPPI CODE  
17 OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT FROM AND AFTER JANUARY 1, 2006, SALES OF  
18 COMPONENT MATERIALS USED IN THE REPLACEMENT OR REPAIR OF CERTAIN  
19 BUILDINGS DESTROYED OR DAMAGED AS A RESULT OF A DISASTER DECLARED  
20 BY THE GOVERNOR AND SALES OF CERTAIN MACHINERY OR EQUIPMENT USED  
21 TO REPLACE MACHINERY OR EQUIPMENT DAMAGED OR DESTROYED AS A RESULT  
22 OF SUCH DISASTER SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM ALL OR A PORTION OF THE  
23 SALES TAX; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."
