SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 29

1 A RESOLUTION TO COMMEND SENATOR LYNN POSEY FOR HIS  
 2 DISTINGUISHED SERVICE IN THE MISSISSIPPI SENATE.

3 WHEREAS, Senator Lynn Posey is retiring from the Mississippi  
 4 Senate to run for state district office after serving 20 years in  
 5 the Senate; and

6 WHEREAS, Senator Posey is a man of integrity and hard work  
 7 and there is an acknowledged respect for the public and business  
 8 endeavors of our esteemed colleague and avid outdoorsman; and

9 WHEREAS, Senator Posey represents the 36th District, which  
 10 comprises Claiborne, Copiah and part of Hinds and Jefferson  
 11 Counties. He has served as Chairman of the Wildlife, Fisheries &  
 12 Parks Committee for 3 terms where he is considered a leader of the  
 13 sportsmen community in our state. He also serves on the  
 14 Appropriations, Business & Financial Institutions, Judiciary B,  
 15 Labor, Municipalities, Public Utilities and PEER Committees; and

16 WHEREAS, Senator Posey serves on the Executive Council of the  
 17 National Assembly of Sportsmen's Caucuses, which is a high-profile  
 18 information exchange group of legislators which advances  
 19 pro-sportsmen's legislation on a national basis; and

20 WHEREAS, Senator Posey is a banker who attended  
 21 Copiah-Lincoln Community College and obtained a Bachelor's degree  
 22 in Political Science and a Master's degree in Mississippi Public  
 23 Policy and Administration from Mississippi State University and  
 24 graduated from the School of Banking of the University of  
 25 Mississippi. His local activities include: Jefferson County

26 Chamber of Commerce, the Small Farmers Advisory Committee, the  
27 local hospital Board of Trustees, the local library Board of  
28 Trustees, the Union Church Volunteer Fire Department, the  
29 Southwest Mississippi Local Planning Council, the Mississippi Farm  
30 Bureau, the National Wild Turkey Federation and the Boy Scout  
31 Advisory Council. He is a Mason and member of the Mississippi  
32 Young Bankers and the NRA; and

33 WHEREAS, Senator Posey was born February 23, 1955, in  
34 Brookhaven, Mississippi. He is married to the former Kathy  
35 Singletary and is of the Baptist faith. The couple has 2  
36 children: Hunter and Kaitlyn; and

37 WHEREAS, Lynn was a source of energy and spirit for the  
38 Senate, often taking on difficult subjects and concerns for the  
39 leadership, and his efforts were always channeled toward what was  
40 best for our state:
