REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 475: Family protection workers; establish scholarship program to obtain college education necessary to become social worker.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

22 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) There is established a scholarship program 23 to encourage family protection workers employed by the Department 24 of Human Services to obtain the college education necessary to 25 become licensed as a social worker, master social worker or 26 certified social worker and become a family protection specialist 27 for the department.

28 (2) Any person who is employed as a family protection worker 29 for the Department of Human Services shall be eligible for a financial scholarship from the Board of Trustees of State 30 31 Institutions of Higher Learning, which shall be used to pay the costs of the person's education at a state institution of higher 32 learning in Mississippi to obtain a college degree that is 33 34 necessary to become licensed as a social worker, master social 35 worker or certified social worker and become a family protection specialist for the department. The annual amount of a scholarship 36 award under the program shall be equal to the total cost of 37 tuition and fees at the college or university in which the student 38 39 is enrolled, not to exceed an amount equal to the highest total 40 cost of tuition and fees assessed by a state institution of higher learning during that school year. 41

Scholarship awards made under the program shall be 42 (3) 43 available to both full-time and part-time students. Students 44 enrolling on a full-time basis may receive a maximum of two (2) 45 annual awards. The maximum number of scholarship awards that may 46 be made to students attending school on a part-time basis, and the 47 maximum time period for part-time students to complete the number of academic hours necessary to obtain the necessary degree, shall 48 be established by rules and regulations of the Board of Trustees 49 of State Institutions of Higher Learning. Scholarships under the 50 51 program shall not be based upon an applicant's eligibility for financial aid. A student must maintain a "C" average or higher in 52 53 his or her college coursework in order to continue receiving the 54 scholarship.

55 (4) After a person who received a scholarship under the program has obtained a college degree that is necessary to become 56 57 licensed as a social worker, master social worker or certified 58 social worker and has received such a license from the Board of 59 Examiners for Social Workers and Marriage and Family Therapists, the person shall render service as a family protection specialist 60 61 for the Department of Human Services for a period of not less than 62 three (3) years from the date that the person became a family 63 protection specialist.

64 (5) Any person who receives a scholarship under the program who fails to complete a program of study that is necessary to 65 66 become licensed as a social worker, master social worker or certified social worker, or who fails to receive such a license 67 68 from the Board of Examiners for Social Workers and Marriage and Family Therapists, shall become liable immediately to the Board of 69 Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning for the sum of 70 71 all scholarship awards made to that person, plus interest accruing at the current Stafford Loan rate at the time the person 72 73 discontinues his or her participation in the program. Any person

07/HR03/HB475CR.J * HR03/OHB475CR.J* (H)PH;UC (S)PH;AP PAGE 2 (RF) G3/5 74 who fails to complete his or her service obligation as a family 75 protection specialist for the Department of Human Services for not 76 less than three (3) years, as required under subsection (4) of 77 this section, shall become liable immediately to the board for the 78 sum of all scholarship awards made to that person, plus interest 79 accruing at the current Stafford Loan rate at the time the person 80 discontinues his or her service. If a claim for payment under 81 this subsection is placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, the obligor shall be liable for an additional amount 82 83 equal to a reasonable attorney's fee.

84 It is the intent of the Legislature that the pursuit of (6) necessary college education by family protection workers through 85 the scholarship program shall not interfere with the duties of the 86 family protection workers with the Department of Human Services. 87 The department shall promulgate regulations regarding family 88 89 protection workers who participate in the scholarship program to 90 ensure that such participation does not interfere with their 91 duties with the department.

92 (7) The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher 93 Learning shall promulgate rules and regulations necessary for the 94 proper administration of the scholarship program established under 95 this section. The board shall be the administering agency of the 96 program.

97 (8) If insufficient funds are available to fully fund 98 scholarship awards to all eligible students, the Board of Trustees 99 of State Institutions of Higher Learning shall make the awards to 100 first-time students on a first-come, first-served basis; however, 101 priority consideration shall be given to persons previously 102 receiving awards under the program.

103 (9) The total amount of state funds that may be expended for 104 this program shall not exceed Three Hundred Twenty Thousand 105 Dollars (\$320,000.00) in any fiscal year.
